

## **TUSB9260 Mass Storage Device Erratum**

<b>Problem:</b>	<b><i>Link state change interrupt sometimes not flagged. Can cause the Link LED's to be incorrect for U1, U2, and U3.</i></b>
<b>Work Around:</b>	None
<b>Severity:</b>	None
<b>Problem:</b>	<b><i>Only the first LPM suspend/resume will work after a device reset with current SS USB hosts.</i></b>
<b>Work Around:</b>	None
<b>Severity:</b>	None
<b>Problem:</b>	<b><i>CP1 and CP2 fails for USB compliance testing with PING with scrambling enabled.</i></b>
<b>Work Around:</b>	Scrambling can be turned off to support automatic compliance pattern transition with PING. Contact <a href="mailto:usb@ti.com">usb@ti.com</a> for a firmware build to complete this test.
<b>Severity:</b>	Compliance only - No Impact to normal operation
<b>Problem:</b>	<b><i>Corrupted SKIPS returned to USB3 Loopback Master. This makes loopback marginal on compliance test.</i></b>
<b>Work Around:</b>	None
<b>Severity:</b>	Compliance only - No Impact to normal operation
<b>Problem:</b>	<b><i>Device may enumerate as HS instead of SS behind a hub after a hot plug event on upstream port of the HUB while VBUS stays active (PWRSWTCH = OFF).</i></b>
<b>Work Around:</b>	Disconnect the USB cable, then re-attach the cable to get a SuperSpeed connection.
<b>Severity:</b>	None
<b>Problem:</b>	<b><i>The TUSB9260 fails the PHY compliance tests for burst and gap length of COMWAKE/COMINIT.</i></b>
<b>Work Around:</b>	None
<b>Severity:</b>	The specification defines three ranges for detecting these signals. The first is the 'shall detect', which the TUSB9260 does not meet. The second is 'may detect', and the TUSB9260 burst/gap lengths easily fall into this range. As a result, no interoperability issues with any SATA devices have been observed.

<b>Problem:</b>	<b><i>Low-impedance receiver termination active when GRSTN is asserted. During power-up, the GRSTN pin will be asserted for a specific amount of time. While GRSTN is asserted, the TUSB9260 Rx termination will be at low-impedance. This can cause to USB3 Host or downstream port of USB3 hub to detect receiver termination and start Polling. If firmware does not enable the Run/stop quickly, the USB3 Host or Downstream port of hub will connect at USB2 speeds instead of USB3.</i></b>
<b>Work Around:</b>	Enable Run/Stop as quickly as possible after GRSTN is de-asserted.
<b>Severity:</b>	None
